From Our Pastor . . .

I know the routine. We have done this before, and I remember well what is involved. At some point between now and Christmas Day, we will find ourselves in a long line coming off I-85 at the McAdenville exit to see the lights in "Christmastown, USA." Ronna has been through McAdenville every Christmas of her life. It is a must-keep tradition. And now, she has passed that love down to our children, who have made it part of their must-keep list of traditions at Christmas.

Ronna has her favorite house, always decorated to a tee: every light in proper place, every wreath hung with care and precision, and the front door will be open, revealing a beautiful Christmas tree in the front room of the house. The children will be on the lookout for the nativity scenes, counting them one-by-one to see how many are on display. And I will be driving through the madhouse of traffic, while noticing the twinkling displays. It really is a great tradition we have kept as a family since Annlyn was a baby, carrying it over from Ronna's childhood. The tradition has stayed the same for years, and will remain intact for years to come. That's the thing about this time of year: our traditions are important to us. They remind us of days gone by and we know they will be there in the days to come.

We are in the early days of the season of Advent. During this season, we light candles when there is less daylight, reminding us that there is a light that shines in the darkness and the darkness will not overtake it (*Jn. 1:4*). During this season, we mark the passing of each week with hope, peace, love, and joy, being reminding all along the way that the incarnation of God in Christ Jesus is the complete fulfillment of hope, peace, love, and joy. The season of Advent places us in a period of waiting as we remember the words of the prophets that one day the Lord's Messiah would come. We find ourselves with Mary & Joseph as they each hear from the angels of the Lord about their son to be born who will bring about the presence of the Almighty One through flesh and blood. Like shepherds huddled out in a field at night watching the flocks, we are stunned and startled by the announcement of the birth of Savior, Christ the Lord. Lest we forget, there are the Magi who travel miles and miles and miles to worship the King of Kings, who is already a toddler by that point.

The prophecies, the announcements, the angelic choir, the visitation of the shepherds, the worship of the magi, it all centers around Jesus. The Christ. The Son of God. The Messiah. The King of Kings and the Lord of Lords. It all revolves around Jesus. There would be no church without Jesus. There would be no nativity scenes without Jesus. There would be no reason for lights in McAdenville without Jesus. There would be nothing without Jesus. John describes Jesus, the Word of God made flesh, like this: *"Everything came into being through the Word, and without the Word nothing came into being."-1:4*

It all comes back to Jesus. Even before there was time, there was the blessed and eternal unity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Before there was Christmas, there was the blessed and eternal unity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. In the days before the birth of Jesus, everything pointed to the moment when the Lamb of God would draw His first mortal breath. In the days during the life and ministry of Jesus, everything He did and said was a revelation of the glory of God, inviting us to gaze upon the One and Only full of grace and truth, which was most clearly revealed in His death and resurrection. Today, everything we, as the church, say and do revolves around Jesus, as we look forward to the day when He comes again. When *that* day comes, all eyes will be on Jesus and all knees will bend before Jesus.

It all revolves around Jesus. Our lives revolve around Jesus. Our congregation revolves around Jesus. I invite you to join me this Advent season as we look back to the days when the people of God were looking ahead to the Advent of the Messiah, and as we look ahead to the second Advent of the Messiah. As it was then, may it be now; as it will be then, may it be now: everything revolving around Jesus.


