# From Our Pastor . . .

Here we are in the season of Lent once again. These weeks when we focus on the cross of Christ, we remember our mortality, we remember that our sin and God's deep love for us is what brings the cross to reality. This journey of Lent is the marking off the weeks leading up to Holy Week and, eventually, to Easter. It is a holy time and a time to draw near to the cross in a very intentional manner.

As a congregation, we are walking our way through the Christ-hymn in *Philippians 2:5*-11 as the way of the cross. It is a necessary way of walking and living, for Jesus calls out to us to lay our own selves down, to take up our own cross and walk with Him all the way to His.

My temptation from time to time is to focus on the cross only this time of year when we are moving our way toward Good Friday and Easter Sunday. However, when that temptation comes, I am quickly reminded that the cross is not just for a weekend, a week, or a season. The cross of Jesus Christ should *always* be the focus of our lives. Whether we are in the season of Lent or not, the cross is our focus. Whether the season of our lives is one of joy or sorrow, the cross is our focus. The cross of Jesus Christ the focus of our days and our nights, our work and our rest, our worship and our service. The cross of Jesus Christ stands in the middle of it all.

As we make our way to Holy Week and Easter Sunday, let us embrace the cross and allow the cross to embrace us, not just for this season, but for our entire lives. Every single day and in every single way, I pray the cross will be our way of life. The season of Lent marks out the way of the cross, but we would do well to remember that this way of the cross is the only way to life. The only way to know the life of Christ Jesus – in all its fullness, power, and light – is to come through the cross. The only way to live out the life Christ Jesus gives us – in all its fullness, power, and life – is through the cross.

Lent is also known as a season of intense prayer and reflection. Many of you keep the practice of holding a Lenten discipline through the season. Lenten disciplines usually involve fasting from something that is taking up too much room in our hearts and lives, and replacing it with prayer and a Holy-Spirit focus on the cross of Jesus Christ. Regardless of whether you engage in this discipline of Lenten fasting or not, I ask you to make our television ministry a serious priority in your prayer life. With the change in management/ownership taking place at the television station, we are unsure at this time what it means for this four-decade ministry the Lord has entrusted to our care.

Let us remember this is the Lord's ministry and it is the Lord's gospel because it is the Lord's cross. I ask you to pray, therefore, for wisdom, guidance, discernment, and the opportunity to minister through the technology of television. This will in no way affect our streaming ministry on YouTube. I ask you to take this ministry and place it at the foot of the cross every single day, even several times a day. Every time you go to the Lord in prayer, please ask the Holy Spirit to guide in a way that will proclaim the death and resurrection of Christ Jesus. Take this on as your Lenten discipline and carve out the time each day to seek the Lord regarding this ministry.

The way of the cross is our way of life. The cross is the focal point of our lives – all we say and do – as well as directing our worship unto the only one worthy of worship, Jesus Christ our Lord. Let us make our way to the cross and let us make the cross our way of life.

Viewmont, Ronna, our children, and I cannot tell you just how much we love you and how grateful we are for you. It is a gift of God's grace to share in this way of the cross with you.
