## From Our Pastor . . .

For almost two years, I have been meeting a couple of guys in downtown Hickory three days a week to exercise. These mornings, though difficult to get into the routine, have proven to be good for my physical and spiritual health. It is not just the walking that strengthens us, but is also our conversation. More often than not, our discussion turns to the work of the Lord, the move of the Lord, and what the Lord has been speaking to us.

Just the other day, it was just two of us out there to exercise and we were riding our bikes. As we rode, we discussed the move of the Lord. In particular, we discussed how often times when the Lord moves in our lives and wishes to move us to a new place, in a new direction, or give us a new task, we can be left wondering why. What is it the Lord wishes to do in our lives? Why do we feel the move of the Lord in this way? What is it the Lord has for us to do?

My friend and I both said that it is only by looking backward that the understanding comes to us. We look in reverse and we realize what the Lord was doing all along. We even say to ourselves, "Oh yeah...now I get it. Now I see what the Lord was doing."

But there comes a crucial moment in life when the Lord is leading. We are left with a choice of what to do. Will we follow where the Lord leads or will we keep to ourselves and say, "You know, I am good where I am. I don't know what this is all about, so I will not pursue it." How often does that happen in our lives? Faith is never easy. However, when we step in faith, when we walk the Easter way, we find the Lord is leading and guiding us all along and, if we will follow Him, if we will invite Him to lead everything, there will be a blessing not possible otherwise.

Take for instance the passage at the end of Luke's gospel: the journey to Emmaus. Here are two disciples of Jesus walking home on the first Easter day. They are downcast and wondering what they have just given so much time to in following this man Jesus. All of a sudden, Jesus is with them. Walking with them. Talking with them. They tell Jesus about Jesus without realizing they are telling Jesus about Jesus. Then, Jesus opens the scriptures to them and tells them all about Himself throughout the history of Israel.

What happens next is a pivotal moment in the journey. They are about to reach their destination. Jesus acts as if He will keep going, leaving the two disciples to themselves. What will happen? The choice is a remarkable one, to be honest. These two disciples are presented with a choice to let Jesus keep going or to invite Him to be with them. This is a choice that will change the rest of the story.

As you and I walk the Easter way, we see these things. We reflect on the move of the Lord in our lives. We look back and see moments in life when Jesus has walked with us and we did not realize we were in the presence of resurrection. But there comes a point when we must make the choice as to what to do with the presence and leading of the Lord. What will we do with the prompting of the Holy Spirit? What we choose changes the direction of where we are headed.

You and I are walking the Easter way together. As we do so, may we recognize the presence of the resurrected Christ, may we journey on together every single day, and may we consistently and constantly choose to follow the Lord. Walking the Easter way strengthens us in a way that nothing else can. One day we will look back and say, "Wow! What a journey!"

I will confess to you that whether our group is walking or riding bicycles, we often feel like the disciples on the road to Emmaus. Christ shows up, walks with us, and stretches us to walk the Easter way ever more.

Viewmont, I love you and it is such a joy to walk the Easter way with you. Let's see what the Lord will do when we follow Him!
